



Follow these steps to make compost in a bottle.

Materials Needed:

Clean 2 liter plastic drink bottle Sharp scissors or craft knife (adult will help with this!) 1 cup of water Organic food waste (banana peel, apple core, egg shells, coffee grounds, tea bags, potato peels, watermelon rind, bread crust) Paper shredded (newspaper, notebook paper, etc.) Soil Soil³ Compost Clear packing tape Push pin

Instructions:

- 1. With help from an adult, cut off the top of the 2 liter bottle and save it for later.
- 2. Push 4 holes in the bottom of the bottle using the push pin.
- 3. Pour a thin layer of soil in the bottom of the bottle.
- 4. Add a layer of organic food waste. To speed the process, cut the waste into small pieces.
- 5. Cover with a layer of soil and Soil³ compost.
- 6. Add a layer of shredded paper.
- 7. Repeat the layers until they are at the top of the bottle.
- 8. The top layer should be Soil³ Compost.
- 9. Sprinkle with water.
- 10, Add worms (pill bugs or beetles will do).
- 11. Replace the top to the bottle using clear packing tape.
- 12. Place your bottle in a plastic plate or bowl near a window.
- 13. Each day add some water and give your bottle a shake. Careful, not too much.

Be patient! The process of composting may take a month or longer. Then, you can use this compost to help grow your own garden.
