

Materials:

One empty 2-liter soda bottle with cap (clean) Small plant (ivy is a good choice) Small rocks or stones (aquarium rocks can add a splash of color) Soil³ Plastic Spoon

Directions:

- 1. Cut the bottom half of the soda bottle. (At least 4 inches from bottom)
- 2. Put about 1 inch of small rocks or stones in the bottom of bottle.
- 3. Add 3 inches of Soil3.
- 4. Use the spoon to dig a small hole in the soil to place your plant. (All of the roots should be in the hole)
- 5. Fill the soil back in around the plant.
- 6. Add water to make the soil moist.
- 7. Place the top of the bottle back on by sliding it over the edges of the bottom.
- 8. Tape around the bottle.
- 9. Make sure the top is on the bottle and place it in indirect sunlight.
