

## Materials:

One empty 2-liter soda bottle with cap (clean)  
 Small plant (ivy is a good choice)  
 Small rocks or stones (aquarium rocks can add a splash of color)  
 Soil<sup>3</sup>  
 Plastic Spoon

## Directions:

1. Cut the bottom half of the soda bottle. (At least 4 inches from bottom)
2. Put about 1 inch of small rocks or stones in the bottom of bottle.
3. Add 3 inches of Soil<sup>3</sup>.
4. Use the spoon to dig a small hole in the soil to place your plant. (All of the roots should be in the hole)
5. Fill the soil back in around the plant.
6. Add water to make the soil moist.
7. Place the top of the bottle back on by sliding it over the edges of the bottom.
8. Tape around the bottle.
9. Make sure the top is on the bottle and place it in indirect sunlight.
